

How Far Is It?

On many of our group walks we do sections of long distance paths. It is surprising how many there are and they are not all included below. Do you know the full distance of some paths in our area? You can work it out!!

Path	Distance
Abberley Amble	Half of two score
Arden Way	$(12 \times 3) - (5 \times 2)$
Centenary Way (Warks)	One less than a century
Cotswold Way National Trail	One more than a century
Coventry Way	This year minus 1980
Diamond Way (North Cotswolds)	Clickety click
Grand Union Canal Walk	Twelve dozen minus six
Heart of England Way	Icecream with a flake plus two
Jurassic Way	Eighth value in eleven times table
Millenium Way	Used to get a telegram from the Queen
Monarch's Way	$(5 \times 100) + (8 \times 10) + (3 \times 1)$
North Worcestershire Hills Marathon	No clues!!!
North Worcestershire Path	One third of $((9 \times 12) - 3)$
Solihull Way	Used to be "key of the door"
Wychavon Way	Two score
